

The Nephrology clinic treats patients with acute and/or chronic renal failure. Referral letter should include a reasonable patient history including which allied health services the patient is already linked to and an up-to-date medication list.

Notes on any relevant pathology/radiology results with copies of results accompanying the referral letter.

Pathology required for renal clinic:

- FBE
- U&E Ca PO4
- ALB
- B12, Folate, Iron Stores
- MSU plus phase contrast microscopy
- If urine dipstick positive for protein-
- eGFR (serial)
- ACR/PCR
- Bp over last six months
- Radiology
- Renal ultrasound

Ensure patients bring all current medications in their original packaging (or Webster pack) including non-prescription medications. Bring any self monitoring diaries such as blood glucose monitoring booklet, symptom diaries, all correspondence from recently attended medical appointments and if applicable.
