Workplace Safety

Every workplace has it's risks. Healthcare settings are no exception. There continue to be alarming rates of serious injury claims from Australian healthcare workers. This week, let's learn more about workplace safety.

Some facts:

- There are over 350 serious injury claims by <u>health</u>care workers each week
- 29% are upper limbs injuries
- 29% are back injuries
- 41% of claims are due to muscular stress while handling objects
- 5% of claims were as a result of being assaulted

Common hazards and risks in healthcare and hospitals

- Lifting, supporting and moving patients
- Moving and handling equipment such as wheelcharis and trolleys
- Work-related stress
- Occupational violence
- Slips, trips and falls
- Bullying and harrassment
