Basic Physician Trainee (BPT) Stream – PGY2+

Bendigo Health is part of the Central North West Basic Physician Training Consortium which offers a comprehensive program, accredited rotations, and is focused on optimising preparation for the written and clinical part of the FRACP examination.

Bendigo Health in partnership with Austin Health have developed a regional BPT pathway that enables Junior Medical Staff to complete up to half of the 3 year training program at Bendigo Health with the possibility of entering into advanced training in a range of specialty areas at Bendigo Health.

We are committed to ensuring progression of our BPT trainees and integrate our training into the training and education with Austin Health in preparation for the examinations.

All rotations are accredited by the RACP and are focused on optimising preparation for the written and clinical part of the FRACP examination in a supportive environment.
