Medical Career Pathways with Bendigo Health

GP Pathway HMO Stream – PGY2+

This GP Pathway HMO position is suitable for applicants seeking a 12 month position that will meet the criteria for Rural Generalist GP training. This position is part of the Victorian Rural Generalist Program (VRGP) and designed to enable HMOs to complete the required college rotations and progress to the GP Training program. The HMO must have already applied to RACGP and/or ACRRM to be eligible for this position and be accepted by the commencement of the clinical year. HMOs applying for this position must be intending to continue their training and career in a rural or regional setting.

Rotations will consist of four, thirteen week rotations, these will include:

• Paediatrics

- Obstetrics & Gynaecology
- Emergency Medicine at Swan Hill District Health
- Anaesthetics/HDU at Echuca Regional Health

Positions available

• 4 HMO Positions – recruited directly by Bendigo Health, Echuca Regional Health and Swan Hill District Health

Teaching Opportunities

- Regularly unit based education and training is available to all JMOs.
- Supported attendance for weekly Intern Education and fortnightly HMO Education.
- Participation in quality and research activities.
- Supervisors of Training and Directors of Training available to provide support and guidance.
- Support to take Professional Development leave to attend relevant courses and conferences.
- JMOs are supported to provide education to others including other professionals
- Multidisciplinary team education and training is provided.

Training Pathway

This position is part of the Rural Generalist program and designed to enable HMOs to complete the required college rotations to progress to the next stages of the GP Training program. HMOs completing this stream will have further opportunities to complete GP Advanced Skills training in a range of



specialties at one of the Health Services in the region or be consider for practice based training at one of the many rural/regional GP practices.
