Surgical Stream – PGY2 and PGY3+ HMOs

This Surgical Stream HMO position is suitable for applicants seeking a 12-24 month position within a sought after rural health service with a focus on surgical services.

This stream is designed to provide HMOs with the necessary rotations, skills and knowledge to progress to college training of their chosen speciality. Rotations would consist of 4x thirteen week rotations from one of the following 8 available positions -

- Participation in quality and research activities.

- Support to take Professional Development leave to attend relevant courses and conferences.
- JMOs are supported to provide education to others including other professionals
- Multidisciplinary team education and training is provided.

Training Pathway

Career Progression at Bendigo Health can include internship, PGY2/3 which will satisfy the requirements in meeting the criteria for college training and can lead to an unaccredited registrar position. The Surgical Stream PGY2/3 years include rotations in surgical and surgical subspecialties in such as urology/ENT, orthopaedics and external rotations to Echuca Health and Swan Hill District Health.
