

Medical Career Pathways with Bendigo Health

Anaesthetics

The Bendigo Health Department of Anaesthesia and Peri-Operative Services provide Anaesthetic Services for approx. 14,000 operative procedures per year. The Department provides a 24- hour service to the people of Bendigo and surrounding districts. The service encompasses intra-operative anaesthesia, pre-anaesthetic assessment, acute pain management, anaesthesia outside the operating suite, and teaching and education throughout the hospital and medical school.

The department is committed to evidence based best practice, continuous quality improvement, research and teaching. The hospital's 11 operating theatres cater for all major types of adult and paediatric surgery (except cardiac and neurosurgery). The hospital is associated with the recognised training programme for medical practitioners who wish to become Fellows of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (FANZCA). Registrars rotate from major teaching hospitals in Melbourne.
