Surgical HMO Stream – PGY2+

This Surgical Stream HMO position is suitable for applicants seeking position within a sought after rural health service with a focus on surgical services.

This stream is designed to provide HMOs with the necessary rotations, skills and knowledge to progress to unaccredited registrar positions then to college training for their chosen speciality.

Rotations would consist of 4x thirteen week rotations, which can include:

- General Surgery
- Urology
- Emergency Medicine at Swan Hill District Health
- Emergency Medicine
- Orthopaedics
- ICU
- General Surgery at Echuca Regional Health

Positions available

- 8 HMO Positions – recruited through the PMCV match process
 - Combination of PGY2 and PGY3+

Teaching Opportunities

- Regular unit based education and training is available to all JMOs.
- Supported attendance for weekly Intern Education and fortnightly HMO Education.
- Ability to participate in quality and research activities.
- Supervisors of Training and Directors of Training available to provide support and guidance.
- Support to take Professional Development leave to attend relevant courses and conferences.
- JMOs are supported to provide education to others including other professionals
- Multidisciplinary team education and training is provided.
