Out of Hospital Cardiac Arrest in Australia

• Over 15,000 Australians suffer a cardiac arrest outside of hospital every year. Sadly, the survival rate from a cardiac arrest is only 10% which is why the first 3-5 minutes holds the key to survival (Victor Chang Institute)

Survivors

- In 2021, the spotlight is on survivors! Using the hashtag #CPRSavedMyLife, ILCOR are gathering stories of survivors who are still with us today thanks to bystander CPR and once more underline the vital importance of CPR in out-of-hospital settings.
- All seven constituent councils of ILCOR are supporting a global initiative to increase awareness about the importance of bystander CPR and to also increase actual bystander CPR rates worldwide.
