PARENT-

- Medicare card

INFANT-

- Clothing, toiletries

- Medications, creams and gels
- Bottles/brush/teats/formula/infant cup/bibs
- Green Child Health Record book
- Favourite toys/dummy
- Sterilising equipment for bottles

- Towels/linen/ pillows
- laundry facilities
- Small safe in own room
- All meals provided for parents and baby (and partner)

PLEASE DO NOT BRING-

- Plastic bags
- Cigarettes and lighters – **BENDIGO HEALTH IS A SMOKE FREE ENVIRONMENT.** Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT) and education is available.

VISITING HOURS-

- One parent admitted for the first 24 - 48hours; then both parents are welcome to stay on the unit providing both are actively involved in the unit's programs.
- Visitors and siblings are welcome between **2pm and 8pm** Monday to Friday allowing for morning groups/programs to run effectively. On weekends there is more flexibility with visiting hours.
