CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE INAUGURAL INNOVATIVE HEALTH RESEARCH AWARD (\$5,000)

Evan Stanyer was a long serving Bendigo Health employee who was passionate about innovative research that translated into improved health outcomes for people. Evan commenced at the Bendigo Psychiatric Centre in the early 1980s and after many years of clinical work in a broad range of mental health areas, moved into the research and innovation space in 2009. His passion for health innovation and research was only equalled by his advocacy for placing the person at the centre of their care. Evan was an inspiration and a mentor to his colleagues. Evan sadly passed away in July 2024 after a brief battle with a very aggressive cancer.

This award recognises an exceptional innovative research idea that demonstrates originality, impact, and potential to improve health outcomes. The winner will receive a \$5,000 stipend, mentorship, and opportunity to turn their vision into reality and make a positive impact on people's health and wellbeing.
